

Working at Height Awareness Course

Course Outline

To provide participants with an understanding of the legislative requirements and the general principles and risks involved with working at height.

Course Objectives

This course should enable attendees to interpret their responsibilities for managing Work at Height and to achieve statutory compliance by providing:

- An Introduction to the Work at Height Regulations 2005 and an evaluation of the impact of these new regulations.
- An understanding of the hierarchy of controls in particular roof working.
- An understanding of Fall Classification and Effect with examples of the types of equipment to prevent and minimisation falls.
- An understanding of the types and inspection requirements of installed safety equipment.
- An appreciation of the different types of access equipment, its usage and inspection requirements.

Duration

Flexibility is a key factor for this training programme. The programme can be adjusted to meet the specific conditions of the delegate's industry. Typically the course is delivered over one day.
